

How to Earn Pins for Your Quilts and Sewing Projects

Measure your quilt along 2 adjacent sides (down the length and across the width). Add those two measurements together to get the total number of inches. Then consult the chart to see how many gold safety pins your quilt has earned. When you get 10 gold safety pins, you can exchange them for a decorative lapel pin to wear on your name tag. Purses and clothing will also earn you pins.

Turn in measurements to Debbie Dunman at the monthly quilt meetings. She will keep a record of pins earned and notify you when you have earned a lapel pin.

For instance, if you complete a quilt that measures 45" x 36", the total inches in length and width is $45+36$ or 81 inches. That quilt would earn you 5 gold pins.

Debbie also has guild pins for sale for \$5. Show your AIQ pride and wear your AIQ pin.
