November Program: Quilted Mementos

Lauren Kingsland, professional quiltmaker, artist and author will present *Quilted Mementos: a Trunk Show* sharing quilts that have represented major steps forward in over 30 years as a fiber artist.

Kingsland's current project, "Quilted Mementos", looks at quilts as tools for personal storytelling. It is supported in part by an Individual Artist Grant from the Montgomery County Arts & Humanities Council in Maryland. Kingsland shared "as we move through life there are important influences and moments which often do not become clear until long after the fact. A careful look back can help us understand how we got where we are and reveal our true selves."

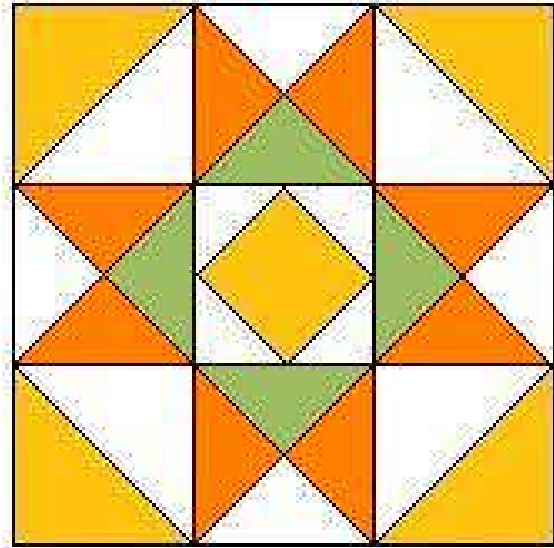

On Balance - Symmetry in Quiltmaking

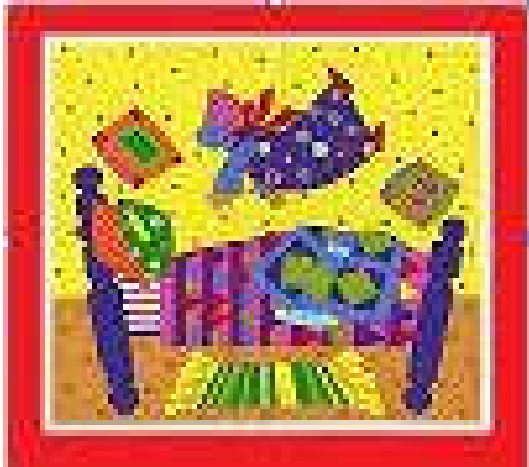
