In the workshop we will explore designs and a wide variety of construction techniques for achieving symmetry in fabric surfaces. Sources of inspiration will include kaleidoscope design, the South Indian kolam, Hawaiian whole cloth quilts and examples of symmetry in modern quilts. Each student will use techniques presented to create the elements of her own personal mandala wall-hanging.

Supply List

- ✓ Backing fabric - 1.25 yds. (something that is really “YOU”)
- ✓ Batting - craft size Quilters Dream Green OR Request OR your favorite
- ✓ Front fabrics - (pick 5 fabrics that make you happy)
 - Fabric A -- 1 yd. - Solid or low contrast print as background
 - Fabric B -- .5 yd. - Print with a line of symmetry (pattern that is a mirror image)
 - Fabric C -- 1 Fat Quarter - Contrast small print
 - Fabric D – 1 Fat Quarter – Black and white print
 - Fabric E -- 1 Fat Quarter – Your choice
 - Assorted strips or other pieces that you particularly like
- ✓ **Line embellishment- 4 yds. - cord, yarn, bias strips, etc. (flexible around a curve)
- ✓ WonderUnder or similar product - 1.5 yds.
- ✓ Thread - gray or to match
- ✓ Scissors- large and small sharp
- ✓ Rotary Cutter/mat/ ruler - straight and triangular
- ✓ Sewing Machine
- ✓ Iron/board/ pressing cloth
- ✓ Pencil, standard and cloth marking
- ✓ Pins
